(Otsuka) announce today the launch of the RIKEN CDB-Otsuka Pharmaceutical Collaboration Center (COCC) at the RIKEN Center for Developmental Biology (CDB) in Kobe, Japan. The COCC aims to elucidate the mechanisms of disease based on a developmental and regenerative biology approach, and to apply this research to drug and new treatment developments.
